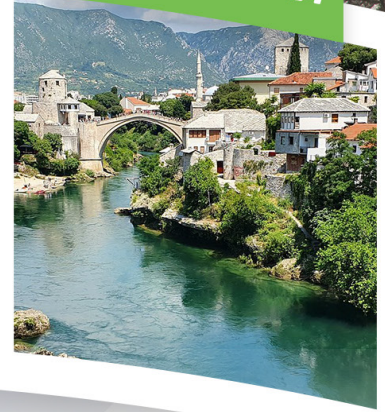

**Inat Kuca** – A symbol of stubbornness and resistance, this house was moved brick by brick to the other bank of the Miljacka River due to the construction of the City Hall. Today it is a restaurant that preserves the spirit of old Sarajevo.

**City Hall** – An imposing building in neo-Moorish style, formerly the National Library, today symbolizes Sarajevo's cultural identity.

**Bascarsija** – The heart of old Sarajevo, a trade and craft center from the Ottoman period, filled with a bazaar atmosphere and rich history.

**Bravadziluk and Kazandziluk Streets** – Authentic Sarajevo streets are known for their craft shops, where you can see the making of traditional copper souvenirs and enjoy traditional dishes.

**Sebilj** – Wooden fountain in Bascarsija from the 18th century, known as the "Sarajevo dovecote" and a tourist must-see.

**Morica Han** – The only preserved inn in Sarajevo, a former stopover for caravans on the Silk Road, and today a popular place to enjoy Bosnian coffee

**Gazi Husrev Bey Mosque** – A masterpiece of Ottoman architecture from the 16th century and the spiritual center of Sarajevo, known for its rich history and beautiful courtyard.

**Latin bridge** – The site of the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand in 1914, an event that was the reason for the start of the First World War.

**Sarajevo Meeting of cultures** – A symbolic point in the city center where East and West meet, Ottoman and Austro-Hungarian architecture, reflecting the rich history of Sarajevo.



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**Old Jewish Temple** – One of the oldest synagogues in Bosnia and Herzegovina, today a museum that bears witness to the rich history of Sarajevo's Jewish community.

**Cathedral of the Sacred Heart of Jesus** – The largest Catholic church in Sarajevo, recognizable by its neo-Gothic style and the statue of Pope John Paul II. in front of the entrance.

**Cathedral Church of the Holy Virgin** – One of the largest Orthodox churches in the Balkans, with distinctive bell towers and a richly painted interior.

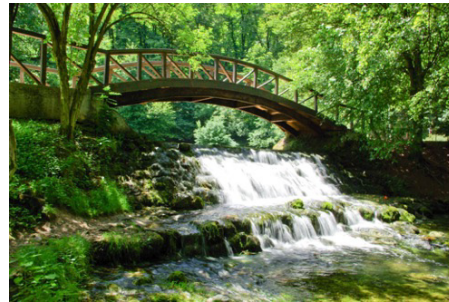
